- Take up the challenge for a round of High Country Mini Golf - available in town next to Delatite Hotel, Howqua Valley Holiday Park or Mansfield Holiday Park.
- Saddle up for an authentic High Country adventure.
 Choose 1 & 2 hour horse trail ride adventures.
- Explore Mansfield's Station Precinct and the bird life at Mullum Wetlands.



BACK TO NATURE WITH THE KIDS!

- Chill out riverside at Jamieson, skim stones, fossick for hidden treasures, throw in a line or hire a kayak.
- Rediscover the days of gold mining at Sheepyard Flat. Follow the river for an easy 1.5 hr return walk to visit iconic Fry's Hut. Keep an eye out for koalas along the way!
- Great for beginners, or little legs! 2 kilometre Plain Creek Loop at Carters Road Reserve – a lovely amble through forest and ferns. Go the longer option onto Plain Creek Waterfall. 7kms 3 hours return.
- Hire an e-bike, BYO your bike to cycle or walk the Great Victorian Rail Trail – gentle gradients, no traffic and perfect scenery await your discovery.
- Take in the awesome views across the lakesides while fishing for yellowbelly, redfin or even Murray Cod. Don't forget kids won't need a licence but adults do.

More hidden treasures for you!

- Stroll the shoreline of Lake Eildon, or ride your bike, to Goughs Bay's Picnic Point lookout - take in the views, have a BBQ, kids' playground, toilets and picnic facilities.
- Rediscover bushranger history at Stringybark Creek, site of the infamous police ambush by the Kelly Gang, and then on to Harry Power's hideout at Power's Lookout for its panoramic views over the majestic King Valley.
- Check out treasures from days gone by at Mansfield's Vintage Traders Emporium.
- Stroll the Glad Phillips Bridge over Lake Eildon at Bonnie Doon.
