#### Along the way...

- Handfeed the animals, laugh at the cheeky meerkats, or be awed by our white lions at the Mansfield Zoo.
- Discover the gnomes as you duck and weave your way through the High Country Maze and Gardens reward offered! Wander 6 acres of walled gardens featuring life sized topiaries.



### TRACKS AND TRAILS TO ENJOY!

#### All Pooch friendly

- Rediscover the days of gold mining at Sheepyard Flat. Follow the river for an easy 3km walk to visit iconic Fry's Hut.
- Hire an e-bike, BYO your bike to cycle or walk the Great Victorian Rail Trail - gentle gradients, no traffic and perfect scenery await your discovery.
- Try a stroll over the Glad Phillips Bridge crossing Lake Eildon at Bonnie Doon.
- A steep but rewarding 4km walk to the summit of Mt Timbertop!
   Commencing at Timbertop Saddle on the Howqua Track.
- Great for beginners, or little legs! 2 kilometre Plain Creek Loop at Carters Road Reserve – a lovely amble through forest and ferns.
   Go longer option onto Plain Creek Waterfall. 7kms 3 hours (return).
- Stroll along leafy riverside on the Jamieson Heritage walk to explore Jamieson's rich heritage. Historic buildings, significant trees and beautiful riverside locations.
- Follow in the footsteps of Ned Kelly as you tread the 1km interpretive
  walk at Stringybark Creek Reserve, site of the ambush and murder of
  3 policemen by the Kelly Gang.

## More hidden treasures for you!

- Stroll the shoreline of Lake Eildon, or ride your bike, to **Goughs Bay's Picnic Point** lookout take in the views, have a BBQ, kids' playground, toilets and picnic facilities.
- Stroll the Mansfield Mullum Wetlands and check out the water birds from the bird hide overlooking the ponds, or just chill on the seating and take in the fresh air and serenity.
- Plant the deckchair and take in the awesome views across the Lake Nillahcootie whilst fishing for yellowbelly, redfin or even Murray Cod. Don't forget kids won't need a licence but adults do.
- Visit Mt Samaria. Spectacular views from Rocky Point Lookout (no dogs allowed).
- Stop to enjoy the incredible views from **Delatite Winery**.
- Up for a challenge? Steep walk to the top of the Paps Scenic Reserve to be greeted with expansive views of the rolling high country hills and Lake Eildon.
